Saturday (1/29)- 7th and 8th Boys play in the Lipan Tournament.





Note From Mrs. Susan

1. If your student has had any of the symptoms (fever, cough, congestion, runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, stomach cramps) in the prior 24 hours before school in the morning, please keep them home. Contact the school secretary to inform them of the absence and then talk to the school nurse to determine if students need to be home any additional days.
2. After 5 days a student must be free of symptoms without medication in the previous 24 hours before they can return to school, If less than 5 days they will need to be free of symptoms for 2-3 days, the school nurse will help you decide on return date.
3. If a household member test positive for covid (either at home or in a clinic). Please keep your student home until you talk to school nurse. If you are waiting on results please keep student home and contact the school secretary and nurse.
4. If you have a doctors release to return earlier, or negative covid test from a doctor or hospital you might be able to return sooner, provided your symptoms are gone.
5. Encourage your student to cover their cough, use hand sanitizers available to them and wash hands frequently.
