

Return To School Plan

The Windthorst ISD return to school plan is based on current CDC guidance safety recommendations. [CDC Guidelines](#) The plan will be reviewed at least every six months and available for public comment.

Mask requirements will follow the state recommendations.

Physical distancing will be allowed by maximizing the use of allowable space. Class desks, chairs, cafeteria tables and seats will be spaces as far apart as possible.

There will be additional class time added to teach and ensure the proper use of handwashing and respiratory etiquette.

Hand sanitizing stations are available at the entrances of buildings and to the cafeteria entrance. Additional cleaning and sanitizing measures will be taken as needed or by request. Water filling stations have been added to replace the use of drinking fountains.

Faculty and students will self-screen.

Vaccinations have been made available to the staff. Information for any vaccination clinics will be made available to staff and parents.

Accommodations for children with disabilities with respect to health and safety will be communicated by the ARD committee based on individual student needs.

Windthorst ISD will coordinate with the Archer County community healthcare, the County Judge, and state officials for any health and safety needs.

Windthorst ISD will continue reducing public access to buildings and cafeteria.

Windthorst ISD will ensure continuity of services, including but not limited to services to address academic, social, emotional and mental health needs of students and faculty by providing additional counseling services and tutoring.
